Nighttime Closure of Brewery Street under Route 34 is Scheduled to begin on Monday, June 7, 2010

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing that Brewery Street under Route 34 will be closed on Monday June 7th, through Friday, June 25, 2010, between the hours of 10 PM to 5 AM.

What to Expect:

The maps on the reverse side illustrates the area detailed.

- Nighttime closure of Brewery Street will occur on Monday, June 7th, through Friday, June 25, 2010, between the hours of 10 PM and 5 AM.
- The ramp to Route 34 will remain open during this time.
- Signs will be posted to help guide you.
- Work will occur weather permitting and will be rescheduled, if necessary.

The work in Contract E2 is part of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing (NHH) Corridor Improvement Program and includes the construction of a new ramp (Route 34 'Flyover' Bridge) from I-95 NB to Route 34 WB at Exit 47 in New Haven. The project also includes reconstruction of the Route 34 WB bridge over Brewery Street, relocation of the Exit 46 ramps at Long Wharf and Sargent Drives and the construction of a second lane from I-91 SB to I-95 SB. The project is in advance of the construction of the new Pearl Harbor Memorial (Q-Bridge) and the I-95/I-91/Route 34 Interchange.
